- Only fill the kettle with the amount of water you need to use, rather than to the top
- Fully fill your dishwasher before running it
- Use a clothes horse to dry clothes instead of the radiators, or if you have outdoor space utilise your washing line
- Move large furniture items away from the radiators so that they don't absorb the heat
- Set your washing machine to 30 degrees
- Clean out the filters of your washing machine and tumble dryer to prevent a build up of debris, which can cause the machines to use more energy to run
- If your washing machine or dishwasher has an 'eco' setting, be sure to use this
- Fully switch off appliances rather than leaving them on standby
